Re: Test and Evaluation of PS-22

Recently, I was given the opportunity to test and evaluate the PS-22 night vision offered by ATN. The first advantage this system has is the quick ability to change from one rifle to another. The system is able to mount to different size and diameter scopes along with the ability to mount several different ways depending on the rifle. The system does not require the scope to be adjusted in any way to maintain the zero in the scope. Many other systems require adjustments that are time consuming and not always accurate. We have a AR style rifle that has the rail system that allowed the system to be mounted securely to the weapon and performed excellent. One set back was the mounting system that mounts directly to the scope. On our Remington 700 models, after about 3 shots, the system wanted to come loose due to the recoil of the weapon. It is a great concept but I believe it needs a tighter securing mechanism to keep the system in place.

In all, I was very impressed with the PS-22. The price is very reasonable for 3rd generation night vision equipment. The system again is easy to move from rifle to rifle and no adjustments are needed on the rifle scope. Hopefully in the near future, we will be able to add a PS-22 system in our inventory.
